## **FOR EVERYONE:**

IN INSTANCES WHICH WRISTBANDS ARE IMPROPERLY WORN<sup>1</sup>. MISSING<sup>2</sup>. ALTERED<sup>3</sup>. DAMAGED, , OR DISCARDED<sup>4</sup> WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. IN ALL OF THE AFOREMENTIONED INSTANCES. YOU MUST PURCHASE A NEW WRISTBAND AT THE ORIGINAL APPLICABLE PRICE FOR ADMITTANCE INTO THE EVENT.

## **FOR COACHES:**

2 (TWO) FREE COACHES WRISTBANDS ARE ISSUED AT CHECK-IN PER TEAM. YOU MUST ENSURE YOU KEEP YOUR WRISTBAND ON FOR THE DURATION OF THE WEEKEND TO AVOID PAYING \$10 TO PURCHASE A NEW WRISTBAND. IF YOU NOTICE YOUR WRISTBAND WEARING OR BEGINNING TO TEAR. PLEASE BRING IT BACK TO US FOR A REPLACEMENT THE DAY OF. 5 COACHES WRISTBANDS ARE NON-TRANSFERRABLE.6

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> Improperly Worn – Wristbands must be always worn on your wrist, otherwise your wristband will be defined as improperly worn, and unacceptable for admittance into the event. Wristbands may not be worn items including but not limited to purses, belts, keychains, backpacks, etc.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> Missing – Any instance in which you do not have the physical wristband with you, no matter the reason.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>3</sup> Altered – The composition of the wristband is in any state other than the original state when issued.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>4</sup> Discarded – Intentionally thrown in the trash, or by other means of disposal

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>5</sup> Bring it back to us – This must be done on the day of wear or tear; we will not accept torn wristbands from Saturday to Sunday morning. You must get a replacement before the end of the event Saturday.

<sup>6</sup> Non-Transferrable – The coaches' wristbands may not be transferred or used by any persons other than the registered coach actively participating in the event and on record with the tournament director. Depending on the event, the site or tournament director may allow a coach to use their second unused free wristband for one spouse, otherwise it is forfeited.
